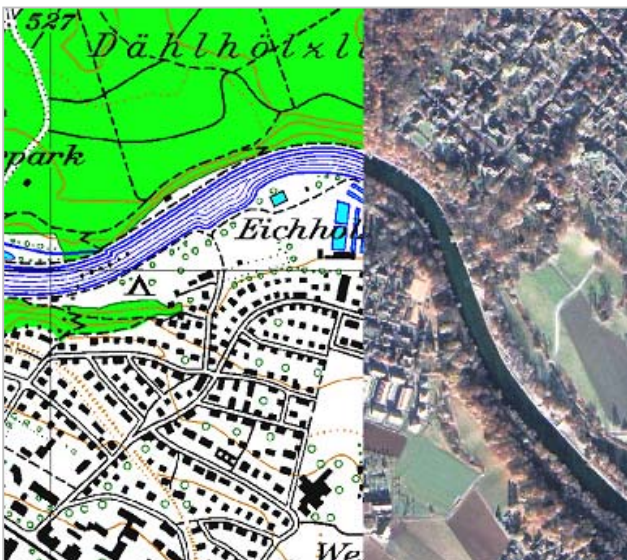

MFB-GeoConsulting produced two briefing maps within a **time frame of ten days** (rapid mapping). Used data sources were digital city maps of the towns around the Lake of Geneva as well as high resolution IKONOS satellite imagery. The IKONOS satellite was programmed for the “area of interest” and data were available within five days. Sufficient time was left for ortho-rectifying the satellite data and for the design of the map layout. All products were generated and delivered within foreseen time frame.
